BLACK CEMETERY, BERLIN, VERMONT

This gem of a cemetery is believed to be the oldest cemetery in Berlin. Located on what is now a dead end road, it is completely surrounded by a stone wall with a granite post on each side of the gateway. The stones are old mostly slate with a few granite. The large monolith on the highest point of the cemetery has lost the urn that was on the top. It is lying on the ground beside the base. A couple of stones have been broken off and are on the ground. A number of stones have become overgrown with lichen and some just show the effects of time. This cemetery was first listed by Raymond and Gertrude Bosworth for the Berlin Historical Society during Aug. and Sept. 1982. Revisited in Sept. 1986 by Jennie Winters. Mapped and verified.

To reach this cemetery you proceed up Crosstown Road from the corners, under the I-89 overpass and turn left. Take a right at the fork and proceed along the Brookfield Road to the first right turn. This will be Black Road. There is a dead end road at the entrance to this road. Black Cemetery is on the left about a quarter of a mile.

There is an American Legion marker and a flag. Directly in front of this stone is a new stone that reads as follows: In memory of Mr. William McAllister who died March 12, 1811. Age 72. He was born at Londondary, N.H. The son of William and Jane Campbell McAllister - Scotch - Irish immigrants, his wife was Mary Clark. He was a soldier in the American Revolution from Jaffrey, N.H.
