Date: February 15, 2021

As a public service, the Berlin, Vermont Zoning Office will provide you with the following information upon request:

- Whether a property is in or out of the Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) as shown on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for Berlin, Vermont.
- Additional flood insurance data for a site, such as the FIRM Zone, the Base Flood Elevation (BFE) or depth, if shown on the FIRM.
- We have a handout on the mandatory flood insurance purchase requirement that applies to people who are getting a federally-backed mortgage or loan for a property in the SFHA.
- 4 Access to Elevation Certificates that have been processed in Berlin, Vermont if they exist for a certain property.
- 5 We have information on historical flooding,
- 6 Information is available if the property is located near a sensitive or wetland area.
