JOHNSTON - SAWYER CEMETERY, BERLIN, VERMONT

The Johnston Cemetery is located on Route 12 about 2 miles south of Montpelier about half way between Montpelier and Riverton. It is on the right side just after the railroad overpass over Route 12. Sharp right and up a slight rise.

This cemetery has many interesting old stones. Some are almost impossible to read because of age and deterioration. I have given each stone a number and have tried to list them in rows that begin at the south end of the cemetery. The first three quarters is row number I through IX, then you walk up a slight incline and near the south fence you will find a family plot that is numbered X. Just behind this row you will find two stones that are near the front (south) side of the fence, then a row up the side of the fence that runs to the back.

This cemetery has a lot of unused space in it. This makes it hard to record. The stones are spread out and a lot of markers have no inscriptions. It was difficult to determine whether they were used to mark graves or to mark lots.

This small cemetery sets on a slight hill among many large trees. It is enclosed on all sides with a fence.

- 2. John Moses died Feb. 4, 1862. Age 68 yrs. Abigail A., his wife, died Sept. 30, 1880. Age 85 yrs.
- 3. A small stone that has the word "Mother".
- 4. Julia A. 4 yrs., 11 mo. Also a small stone. At the foot of each head marker is a small granite marker with no writing, numbers 2 through 5.
- 5. Daniel T. 5 yrs., 7 mo. This is a small stone.
- 6. Maria A. Moses died Jan. 27, 1896. Age 20 yrs. "We miss you dear sister"
- 7. Sarah J Moses, July 18, 1829 April 2, 1905.
- 19. Tall Monument. Hayden, Dame, Submit, John, Hannah, wife of John, and Esther.
- 22. Phebe B., wife of Harvey Johnston, died Sept 3, 1880. Age 74 yrs.
- 27. Rev. James Sawyer died July 11, 1859. Age 94 yrs., 6 mos.
- 28. Anna, wife of James Sawyer 2nd, died Aug. 1, 1819. Age 39 years.

- 29. James Sawyer died March 5, 1801. Age 68 yrs.
- 30. Lydia, wife of James Sawyer, died April 16, 1814. Age 79 yrs., 11 mo.
- 31. James Sawyer died aged 29 yrs. Betsey Ann, daughter of J. & L. Sawyer. Age 14 yrs. There is more on this stone but it can't be read.
- 32. Edward Sawyer died May 3, 1849. Age 86 yrs.
- 33. Salley Sawyer died Jan 4, 1880. Age 67 yrs., 11 mo.
- 34. Lydia Sawyer died June 16, 1881. Age 73 years, 4 months, 6 days.
- 35. Norman D. Sawyer born Feb 10, 1819, died Sept. 2 1885. "At Rest".
- 47. Col. Cyrus Johnston died July 25, 1860. Age 88 yrs.
- 48. Polly, wife of Col. Cyrus Johnston, died Feb. 9, 1827. Age 56 yrs.
- 49. Peter, son of Cyrus & Polly Johnston, died Sept. 20, 1801. Aged 2 yrs.
- 50. P. Johnston. The writing is too faded to read.
- 51. Hannah H. Johnston died January 22, 1857. Age 27 years.
- 52. Robert Johnston died Sept. 11, 1812.
- 53. Arpaeliza Johnston, wife of Robert Johnston, died March 17, 1887. Age 88 years, 8 months.
- 54. Fred E. Johnston, son of C. H. and L. D. Johnston, died January 23, 1863. Age 1 year, 10 months, 3 days.
- 55. Arthur V. Johnston, son of C. H. and L. D. Johnston, died May 19, 1861. Age 2 years 26 days.
